Stakes

Gauteng and Eastern Cape

In September 2020, the RA notified Phumelela and Kenilworth Racing that we were no longer able to supplement stakes after 30 November 2020. The RA has continued to negotiate with the race operator and early in November it was announced that Phumelela, in order to assist with the sustainability of the industry while the new race operator awaits the necessary regulatory approvals, has agreed to absorb the 20% contribution to stakes recently funded by the Racing Association in Gauteng and the Eastern Cape.

This will enable stakes to be maintained at current levels to the end of February, by which time, regulatory approvals should have been received..

This is a challenging environment for businesses to commit to sponsorship. However any race sponsorship income sourced by Phumelela or The Racing Association will continue to be used to bolster stakes further. Thanks to Phumelela for securing a generous sponsorship from World Sports Betting for the Gauteng Summer Cup (G1) where the stake has been increased to R 1 Million.



In addition to the above, there will be a small uplift to the stakes in the Eastern Cape from a level of R40 000 to R50 000 for all minor races.

Western Cape

In the Western Cape an exciting announcement from Kenilworth Racing introduced the restructuring of stakes levels for both the feature race schedule as well as the all-important regular race programme that sustains horseracing week in and week out. A local stakes committee with representation from the RA, Kenilworth Racing and independent racing stakeholders was tasked with exploring a more economical way of distributing the stakes increase in the Cape with "in-season" and "out-of-season" levels.

Feature Races

The budgeted stakes are based on the current COVID-19 levels as agreed to by the stakes committee. However, Kenilworth Racing has agreed to implement stakes increases across the board.
