From the desk of the CEO



Welcome to the June edition of RA Today!

Unfortunately, this month has not been a good one for racing in South Africa and for Gauteng in particular. Just when we were starting to enjoy good racing, hospitality and improvements at our racecourses, the third wave of Covid-19 has taken over and we have moved to Adjusted Alert Level 4. We deemed it sensible to introduce "racing behind closed doors" in Gauteng prior to enforcement by national government in the best interests of our members. Unfortunately, following the announcement by President Ramaphosa on Sunday 27 June, it has been necessary to extend the closure of restaurants and restrict attendance at racecourses by owners nationally. Only persons in receipt of Essential Permits will be permitted to attend race meetings. The situation will be carefully considered on Sunday, 11 July 2021 to establish if there have been any positive changes that may permit any relaxations to these protocols.

Thankfully, Gold Circle have confirmed that the Vodacom Durban July race day will go ahead on Saturday, 3 July 2021 albeit behind closed doors. The race meeting will be available to view on Tellytrack (DSTV Channel 249) and via the official broadcast on SuperSport 4 (DSTV Channel 204) from 13h00-16h00

on Saturday. The 1st race is off at 11h15 with the VDJ run at 15h00 and the 10th race off at 16h45. More information can be found at www.vodacomdurbanjuly. co.za

After foregoing membership subscriptions for an extended period, the Racing Association has posted invoices for RA membership for the 2021/22 season. The Board has taken a decision not to increase the subscription fees for the upcoming season.

As mentioned in previous newsletters, we are looking into tiered membership and more information on these extra top up benefits will be published over the coming months. Some of the new initiatives have had to be postponed due to Covid restrictions as well as the delays in the new operator obtaining approvals from the various gambling boards.

In closing this month, I would just like to wish all of our members as well as all of the participants in our industry good health and best wishes to stay safe. We are moving through very difficult times both personally and professionally and we as the RA continue to strive to productively advance the industry in any way we can. Stakes on Highveld and in Eastern Cape get big boost

The Race Operator released information on 21 June that ahead of the transfer of the horseracing and tote business from Phumelela to 4Racing, the parties are pleased to announce that initiatives are being undertaken to enhance the business through additional support of horseracing.

- * Stakes for minor races in the Eastern Cape will increase from R50,000 to R60,000 per race in July. Additionally, Listed and Non-Black Type feature races in the Eastern Cape will increase from R85,000 to R100,000 and R80,000 to R90,000 respectively.
- * From the start of the Highveld Spring Season in October, minor races in the three current tiers will increase from R70,000 to R85,000; R77,500 to R92,500 and R85,000 to R100,000 respectively. Simultaneously, Maiden Plates will receive an even bigger increase and rise from R70,000 to R90,000.

In addition, SAEHP (SA Equine Health & Protocols) has been provided with funding to stabilise its operations which were disrupted during lockdown.

Good News for SAEHP

Efforts have been ongoing relating to export of South African horses and it was inspiring to hear that the Hong Kong Jockey Club has partnered with SAEHP to fund the export drive. While many may have grown weary of the length of time the export drive has taken, SAEHP has made solid strides since their inception in 2018. It was a bitter blow to their efforts that after all the hard work in getting the disease control measures up to standard for the audit COVID then caused the cancellation of the audit. Since then SAEHP has struggled to obtain financing, the RA and other industry stakeholders have continued the funding for this vital cause in spite of the difficult times. SAEHP Chair, David Abery and MD Adrian Todd also

approached the HKJC for assistance. The Club in what can only be described as an amazing vote of confidence in both the quality of South Africa's bloodstock and the credibility of the work that has been conducted by SAEHP, stepped in and will fully fund the efforts going forward. This very public affirmation of the South African racing industry speaks volumes as to the international potential of our industry. The funding mechanism via the simulcast of South African racing also brings in much needed additional income to racing operators. We are very fortunate as an industry to have supporters such as the HKJC.
