The Equus public vote mechanism

The voting platform will be hosted on the Equus Awards website (www.equusawards.co.za). All polls (categories) will be on the same webpage. Each category with a public vote component will have its own poll with options made up of pre-selected 'finalists'. One vote will be allowed per category per user. The system will require that users enter their email addresses for



JULY 2022 Mary Slack

It was a happy occasion in mid June when Mary Slack won the Grade 3 Hampton Court Stakes with Claymore at the Ascot festival. I would hazard a guess that the smile had barely disappeared from her face with this delightful victory when the Hollywoodbets Durban July was upon us.

The determination of the team involved with the 4 year old filly Sparkling Water (Silvano (Ger) – Espumanti (GB) by Dansili (GB), who was bred at Wilgerbosdrift and Mauritzfontein Stud, all played a vital role in Mary Slack winning her first Durban July. She is the daughter of the well-known racing family Harry and Bridget Oppenheimer who had won this prestigious South African race on no less than 6 occasions.

In drawing to the closing stages of the 2022 race, the well-known black and red Slack colours could be seen making what appeared to be easy headway to the finish under the guidance of S'Manga Khumalo. The popular victory was spectacular for a number of reasons and was considered to be what fairy tales are made from. Firstly, Sparkling Water was the only filly in a strong field filled with class. It was also Mary's first July win and quite a while since trainer Mike de Kock had entered the number 1 box to lead in the winner of this famous race. And then there was Bling Khumalo who just finished off the perfect story line.

Mary has a passion for all forms of the equine industry but it all started in the show jumping arena. Under the influence of her parents, she became involved in the thoroughbred breeding industry and later invested in Wilgerbosdrift Stud Farm. Mary has been a member of the Racehorse Owners Association since its inception in 1997 and is a life member. She was also a Trustee on the Thoroughbred Horseracing Trust where she played a vital role in being part of a number of transformation projects which included the Grooms' riding initiative with James Maree. It was during this time while serving on the Trust that Khumalo decided to try his hand at becoming a jockey.

Well done Mary – you truly are a worthy Owner of the Month.
