The Dahlia Plate (L), run on the same day, was won by Ekorja. Congratulations to all of the connections. The ROA was delighted to invite and entertain guests in the Bold Silvano Room at Fairview and an enjoyable day was had by all.

In the Western Cape, the 2nd leg of the Winter Series was run on Saturday, 21 May. Gem King won the World Sports Betting Legal Eagle Stakes (Grade 3) at Kenilworth over 1800m. This follows up on his fluent victory in the World Sports Betting Variety Club Mile last month, which was the opening Leg of the Winter show-down. Congratulations to owners Greenacres Trust (Nominee: Mr N M Shirtliff) and Mr Bryn Ressel. The R150,000 WSB Stormsvlei Stakes (Listed) over 1800m was won by Maria Querol and congratulations go to owners Greg Bortz and AJ van Huyssteen.

As the temperature in Gauteng begins to drop and we move in to the winter months, feature racing moves to Kwa Zulu Natal. We have already had some memorable racing with, just this weekend, Drakenstein Stud (Nominee: Mrs GA Rupert) earning another two Grade 1 wins with Woolavington 2000 (G1) winner Silver Darling victorious

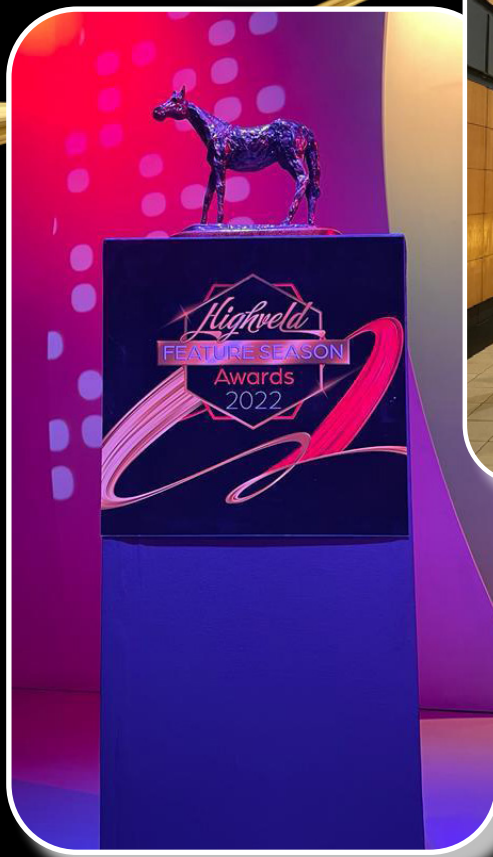

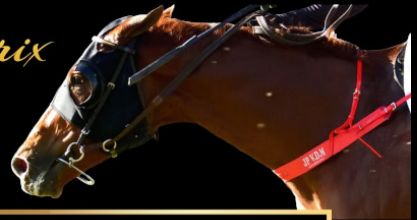

TAB is committed to making betting as convenient as possible for all customers and in terms of that TAB betting on all South African race meetings will open as early as is possible in future.

Historically TAB has opened betting pools on the day of local race meetings with the exception of selected major meetings. Going forward, however, TAB betting will be available from the day after the official racecard for a local meeting has been published subject to certain limitations arising from the betting keys used for each area by TAB4Racing, TABKenilworth Racing and tabGold.

In the case of TAB4Racing and TABKenilworth Racing, Vaal, Turffontein, KwaZulu-Natal (Hollywoodbets Greyville and Scottsville), Eastern Cape (Fairview) and Western Cape (Durbanville and Kenilworth) each has an allocated betting key.

Betting on any of those venues/racecourses can be opened once the official racecard is published provided there is not another race meeting utilising the same betting key beforehand. Thus if there are Turffontein meetings on say a Wednesday and a Saturday, TAB betting on the Saturday meeting cannot be opened until the Wednesday meeting is completed.

In the case of tabGold there are only three betting keys for South African race meetings – Eastern/Western Cape, KZN and Vaal/Turffontein.

Consequently if there is racing at Kenilworth on a Wednesday and Fairview on a Friday, tabGold will only open betting on Fairview once the Kenilworth meeting is completed.

Brian Finch announced as Chair Epsom Downs Racecourse

Brian Finch will succeed Julia Budd as the Chair of Epsom Downs Racecourse, The Jockey Club announced in May.

The appointment will take effect from Monday 6th June, immediately after the 2022 Cazoo Derby when Julia Budd's term concludes.

A passionate racing fan since childhood visits to Borrowdale Racecourse in Harare, Zimbabwe, Brian has been involved in racehorse ownership for more than 25 years in various countries including the UK.

Also a keen student of bloodstock and pedigrees, his first experience at Epsom Downs came in the Queen's Diamond Jubilee year of 2012. Brian joined the Epsom Racecourse Committee in 2021.

Brian, who has had a home in Epsom since 2005, spent most of his working career with a British multinational company. Currently retired, Brian is a member of the Racecourse Committee at Sandown Park Racecourse and a Trustee of the National Horseracing Museum.

Julia Budd became Chair at Epsom Downs in June 2016 and during her tenure has overseen a rise in The Derby's prize money value to £1.5million, ensuring it remains the richest race run in the UK.

Her leadership was instrumental through the challenges created by the pandemic and her term has also seen the strengthening of ties between the racecourse and the local community in which it sits.

Brian Finch said: "I am delighted and hugely honoured to succeed Julia at Epsom Downs, a racecourse that will soon host the 243rd running of the iconic Derby.

"I very much look forward to working with the Jockey Club team to build on the great work of my immediate and past predecessors ensuring that the Derby and Epsom Downs racecourse continue to remain part of the national social fabric."

Sandy Dudgeon, Senior Steward of The Jockey Club, said: "I am delighted that Brian has agreed to become Chair of Epsom Downs Racecourse following this year's historic Derby.

"His experience both inside the racing industry and beyond, coupled with his huge enthusiasm for the sport and Epsom Downs will be a huge asset as our stewardship of this iconic racing venue and its most famous race enters a new and exciting chapter.

On behalf of the Racehorse Owners Association, we wish Brian all the best in his new position.

ROA OWNER OF THE MONTH

JOHNNY PETER

Well done Johnny Peter on winning the ROA Owner of the Month Award. There were huge celebrations at Turffontein Racecourse on 30 April when his brother, Paul Peter-trained Astrix (Vercingetorix (SAF) romped home winning the Grade 1 Champions Challenge. Earlier that day, Maharanee (Flower Alley (USA) Indira (SAF) by Tiger Ridge (USA) delivered her third career victory from three starts when winning the SA Fillies Nursery.

When asked, Johnny said that all of his horses are with his brother Paul Peter, but he may look to give horses to other trainers in the future. I would think it goes without saying that it is not only because Paul is his brother but also because he runs an incredibly successful stable. Johnny said "We are Lebanese and full of traditions, many of which I uphold in my family."

It was some 40 years ago when he entered the exciting world of thoroughbred horseracing and he

is proud of the fact that he received his first set of colours when he was 21 years old from the late respected gentlemen, Laurie Jaffe and Gerald Rosenberg. At the time he was the youngest colour holder registered with the Jockey Club. His first acquisition was named Shooting High - trained by Jean Heming, who earned him two Grade 1's and the rest was history. He was totally hooked and got the impression that the game was easy - Johnny has been an addict ever since.

Johnny announced that the stable has just received a yard of 30 boxes in KZN so our horses will be split between Gauteng and KZN. He said he is extremely impressed by the way Hollywoodbets have turned around KZN racing for the better.

He felt it appropriate to say a few words about his "baby brother" Paul Peter. "Paul has brought such joy and satisfaction in all his achievements as a race horse trainer. It reminds me of the race between the tortoise and the

hare. The other trainers let Paul nibble away at the maiden plates and when they realized that he was so far in front on the trainers log, they all started chasing their tails. Hopefully he is far enough ahead to win it. My late Dad who was an avid racing supporter, would be very proud of Paul today."

Victory continued for this gentleman of the turf during this month as there was much to celebrate at the 2022 Highveld Feature Season Awards on 21 May. Astrix owned by Mr GD Tooch and Hyperpaint Syndicate (Nominee: Mr JT Peter) was awarded the Champion Middle Distance Horse and Maharanee owned by Mr MK Nkale and Hyperpaint Syndicate (Nominee: Mr JT Peter) won the Champion Two year old filly Award.

I am sure we can wish this humble family well on behalf of all ROA members and may they go from strength to strength.

GO IN PEACE LESTER PIGGOTT

Lester Piggott was no stranger to racegoers in South Africa. Probably the most famous jockey of all time, Piggott started visiting South Africa to ride mainly out of the English season, in the 1970's. This popular sportsman would pack the racecourses to capacity and Piggott smoking his Cuban cigars, would be a familiar sight.

He participated in the Bull Brand International at Scottsville, sponsored

by Cyril Hurwitz. There is a famous story of Lester Piggott on board The Malster, owned and trained by Mr JBK Cooper. The Malster was left at the start and lost almost 100 metres, partly because Piggott was swearing at the starter. He then took off and produced a convincing win on the Malster and said it was probably the best race he had ever won. Needless to say, he did not get off scot-free and was

issued with a fine for his ungentlemanly conduct.

Piggott achieved his first victory at the age of 12 years old. He was crowned champion jockey 11 times which included 9 Derby wins, 8 St Legers, 6 Oaks, 5 x 2000 Guineas and 2 x 1000 Guineas. Piggott earned 4493 career wins that included 116 Royal Ascot wins and 30 British Classic victories.
