The 2022 Betway Summer Cup was a golden Joburg horseracing and lifestyle events success as Puerto Manzamo storms to victory

Johannesburg's biggest horseracing event and one of the city's top lifestyle and fashion attractions, the Betway Summer Cup, burst back into life on Saturday as punters flocked to a vibrant Turffontein Racecourse in droves.

Dubbed 'The Golden Summer' as a tribute to the City of Gold's return to bustling events and activity, punters and racegoers heeded the theme with fashion that was a glittering sight, as racegoers embraced the Golden Summer theme on an entertaining race day hosted by racing operator, 4Racing.

ROA OWNERS OF THE MONTH

November 2022 Colin and Lynn Stonebridge

It is with pleasure that we congratulate Colin and Lynn Stonebridge on being the ROA Owners of the Month for November 2022.

The owners of Bingwa are involved in 14 individual and partner ownerships that comprise 10 horses with trainer Johan Janse van Vuuren here on the Highveld, and 2 down in Kwa-Zulu Natal with Alyson Wright at Summerveld (one of which, won the www.tabgold.co.za MR 63 HANDICAP as recently as the 28th of November 2022). They also have shares in 2 horses with two trainers in Cape Town.

Lynn started racing around 1992 with her father, and in 1997, her and Colin took over her father's colours and have been racing in them ever since. 25 years later, they have celebrated some very successful and memorable moments in racing. Looking back to where it started, their first trainer was Gerald Parker in Zimbabwe, and thereafter had numerous horses trained by all Borrowdale trainers through their own horses or syndicates. Their first horses in Johannesburg went to Paul Matchett and another group to Nolene Peech in KZN. They ended up in Port Elizabeth with Dorrie and Mark Sham who then moved up to the Highveld with them. When Dorrie and Mark retired, their horses were moved to Johan and Alyson.

The Stonebridges have in the past, been very involved in breeding in Zimbabwe and after leaving, had 3 mares at Narrow Creek Stud. Currently the only mare they own is Marauding Lady (Century Stand (AUS) X Marauding Lady (ZIM)), Bingwa's mother.

Colin and Lynn have 3 sons, and the entire family is involved with racing, Lynn and Dale's passion are the horses, breeding and pedigrees while Dean, Ian and Colin love the racing aspect. Their sons Ian and Dean live in Scotland and Dale lives in Johannesburg. Colin who works in the tobacco industry lives together with Lynn in Morogoro, Tanzania. The family enjoys beach holidays and the wildlife that living in Tanzania has to offer.



When asked about the most memorable victory since the start of his racing and owning experience, Colin was elated and described a few. These include winning the Juvenile Triple Crown with Pollenate in Zimbabwe, who sadly, shortly after the Juvenile series, passed away and ended his career unbeaten from 6. Another memory is that of winning their 1st SA Graded race with Killaridge on July day and finally, winning the Grade 2 Allied Steelrode Charity Mile two years in a row with Bingwa, a feat which has not been done since Wolf Power!

Lynn has been an ROA member since 2005 and Colin signed up in 2011, they love the ROA for the lunches and facilities on course and they look forward to the newsletter each month. Unfortunately, being out of the country they do not get to the racecourse as much as they'd like. We look forward to welcoming the Stonebridges when they do make their next trip to the races and congratulate them once again on being named our ROA Owners of the Month for November.
