Partnership between the ROA and 4Racing see the provision of Medical and Funeral Benefits for Grooms.

► Several months ago, a group of dedicated stakeholders came together with a mission to make a difference in the lives of previously marginalised individuals. Grooms and Stable Hands are the backbone of the horseracing industry, working tirelessly behind the scenes to ensure every race is a success. Despite their dedication, many of these workers faced significant challenges. Often, they lacked access to basic services despite being integral to the success of the industry.



The ROA have partnered with 4Racing with a shared goal: to provide these workers with the support and resources they need to thrive.

It was with great enthusiasm, that 4Racing approached the ROA and together we have identified key areas that require assistance, namely medical and funeral benefits for Grooms. The team has worked over several months to create a programme that could support medical expenses and offer assistance to the Grooms in case of any accidents or illnesses. We have also sought to provide funeral services for grieving families, ensuring that Grooms' loved ones could provide a loving and dignified send-off.

During the month of March, registration drives for Grooms were held at Fairview, the Vaal, Randjesfontein and finally at Turffontein on Monday, the 27th. These events provided an opportunity to speak to this worthy initiative as well as

to 4Racing's roll-out of other important projects such as the upgrade of grooms' accommodation and most significantly the ground-breaking Grooms Trust that will give Grooms and Stable Hands a considerable stake in the 4Racing business.

We received good media coverage, and our message has been well received.

We have scheduled 4 Wellness Days during the month of April at each training centre and I encourage any owners who would like to attend these days or to get more information on this initiative to please get in touch with us. We know that the real power of this initiative lies in the spirit of collaboration. Together, we are greater than the sum of our individual parts and by joining hands and working together we will be able to create a more

just, equitable, and supportive horseracing industry for all.

► **Landmark 4Racing Transformation Initiative sees 26% of the company transferred to a Grooms and Employees' Trust, along with a wide range of historic Grooms' benefits**

When the Competition Commission approved the transaction between Phumelela and 4Racing on 31 March 2021, 4Racing made a commitment to contribute to the transformation of not only the organisation, but the horse racing industry as a whole.

In December 2022, the Competition Commission approved the implementation of the 4Racing Transformation Initiative, which will see a 26% shareholding of the company apportioned between a Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Trust



(BBOS), the beneficiaries of which will be Grooms and Stable Hands, and an Employee Share Ownership Programme (ESOP) being established for 4Racing employees.

4Racing has appointed an independent Trust Administrator to handle the establishment and administration of the Grooms and Employees' Trust. A total of 16% of the company's shares will be issued to the Grooms and Stable Hands' Trust (BBOS) and 10% to 4Racing Employees (ESOP).



"Grooms are one of the most crucial parts of the horse racing industry," said 4Racing Chief Executive Officer, Fundi Sithebe.

"They are also traditionally, the most marginalised stakeholders."

"This landmark approval by the 4Racing Board of the funding for the Grooms Trust initiative is a massive moment in the history of South African horseracing. The Grooms Trust will genuinely empower Grooms and Stable Hands and we are extremely proud of the progressive

steps being made to improve the holistic living standards of these very important stakeholders, as well as by the formation of the Employees' Trust."

► Upgrading of Grooms Accommodation

The 4Racing Board commissioned a property solution company to conduct a thorough assessment and investigation into the state of the Grooms accommodation at all 4Racing's racing and training facilities.

The findings were that the Turffontein Grooms' lodging was in need of renovations and that the accommodations at Randjesfontein and Vaal were well-maintained and that no immediate action was required there.

The company will renovate the existing Grooms' accommodation at Turffontein and work on the eight-month project has already begun, with a number of Grooms currently moved to temporary accommodation while their living quarters are being renovated.

World Sports Betting commits R52 million to sponsoring 4Racing's major horseracing events in Johannesburg, Vaal and Nelson Mandela Bay

Major sports bookmaker, World Sports Betting, has significantly increased its investment in South African horseracing by committing a minimum R52 million towards the sponsorship of 4Racing's blue-chip events in Gauteng and Eastern Cape over the next three years.

World Sports Betting, renowned sponsors of the World Sports Betting Triple Crown Series that traditionally kicks off the Gauteng horseracing season, are proudly the new and official sponsors of 'The Championships' season in Johannesburg, which will now come to be known as 'The World Sports Betting Championships'.

In addition to the first three legs of the World Sports Betting Triple Crown, held annually and in tandem with the Wilgerbosdrift Triple Tiara, The World Sports Betting Championships will also include the Royal Race Day, headlined by the Her Serene Highness Princess Charlene Empress Club Stakes, and the eagerly anticipated Champions Day, which is the Finale of The World Sports Betting Championships.

As part of their exciting partnership and a minimum of R52 million sports marketing investment in 4Racing, World Sports Betting will continue to sponsor the Vaal's big racing day out, the Grand Heritage, and the East Cape Derby at Fairview over the next three years.

The deal will also see World Sports Betting invest significantly into 4Racing's digital and broadcast programming on Racing 240 all-year-round, as well as its magazine show Weighted To Win, along with activations around major WSB race days.

World Sports Betting have proudly announced that they will commit a further R7 million to Grooms' CSI initiatives, with every winning Groom under the 4Racing umbrella being awarded a generous R1 500 cash incentive.

"This investment by World Sports Betting into the future sustainability of South African horseracing is hugely significant.

We appreciate their confidence in and support for The World Sports Betting Championships season, which has added a new dimension to the start of the Johannesburg horseracing season. We are also appreciative of WSB's sponsorship of our major race days in the Vaal and Nelson Mandela Bay. While the horseracing industry remains under pressure to ensure its long-term survival, we are heartened by the partners who have come on board to put their name, energy and support behind our major race days on the 4Racing calendar and to ensure stakes remain competitive. We will continue to make the sport of horseracing appealing to existing and potential new punters, owners, trainers, corporates and all stakeholders who are strongly invested in the much-loved sport of horseracing," said 4Racing Chief Executive Officer, Fundi Sithebe.

"We are proud and more so honoured to be part of this journey and partnership with 4Racing. Our aim and vision go hand in hand with that of the 4Racing Executive team and all major players and contributors to ensure the sustainably and longevity of the sport we live and breathe. Our plan is to welcome a new life into the sport of racing, creating awareness, an element of fun and lifestyle too. We look forward to a long and fruitful partnership with 4Racing," said World Sports Betting Group Holdings CEO, Warren Tannous.

The third leg of the World Sports Betting Championships, the R4.3 million Derby Day, takes place at Turffontein on Saturday 1 April, headlined by the R1.5 million World Sports Betting SA Derby (Grade 1), R1 million HF Oppenheimer Horse Chestnut Stakes (Grade 1) and the R750 000 Wilgerbosdrift Bridget Oppenheimer Oaks (Grade 2).

The World Sports Betting Championships continues on Saturday 15 April with the Royal Race Day, headlined by the R1 250 000 HSH Princess Charlene Empress Club Stakes (Grade 1), as well as the Racehorse Owners Association's R300 000 Monaco Sport of Kings Charity Maiden Sprint.

The World Sports Betting Championships' Finale concludes on leg five with the high-octane R4 895 000 Champions Day on Saturday April 29, which is a major highlight on the South African horseracing calendar packed with top quality Graded races galore.

Champions Day includes the R2 million Grade 1 Premier's Champions Challenge, the Middle Distance Championship, and the R1 million Grade 1 Jonsson Workwear Computaform Sprint,

the quickest 1000m event in the land which crowns the best sprinter.

The day also contains a host of Championship Graded races for Juveniles, Fillies and Mares.

The World Sports Betting East Cape Derby takes place on Friday 12 May 2023, while the World Sports Betting Grand Heritage at the Vaal takes place on Saturday 9 December this year.

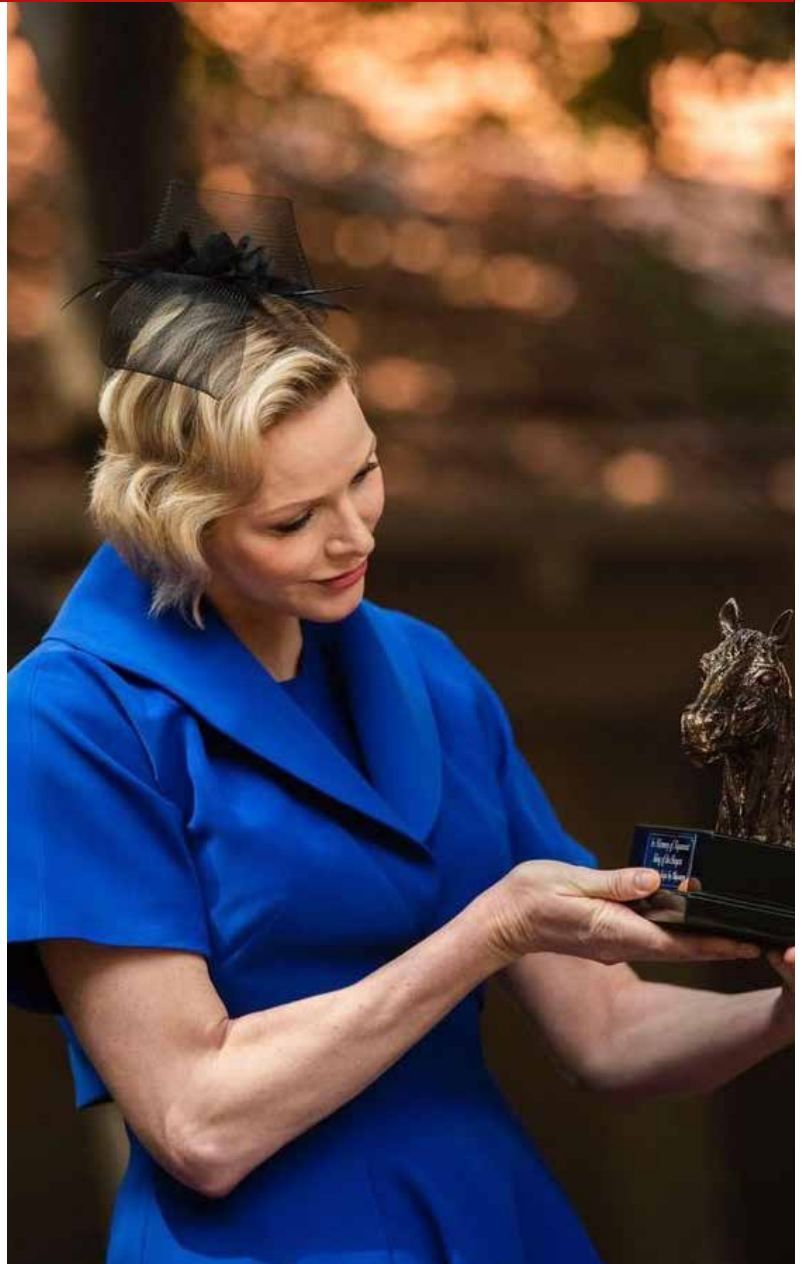
The Royal Raceday 2023

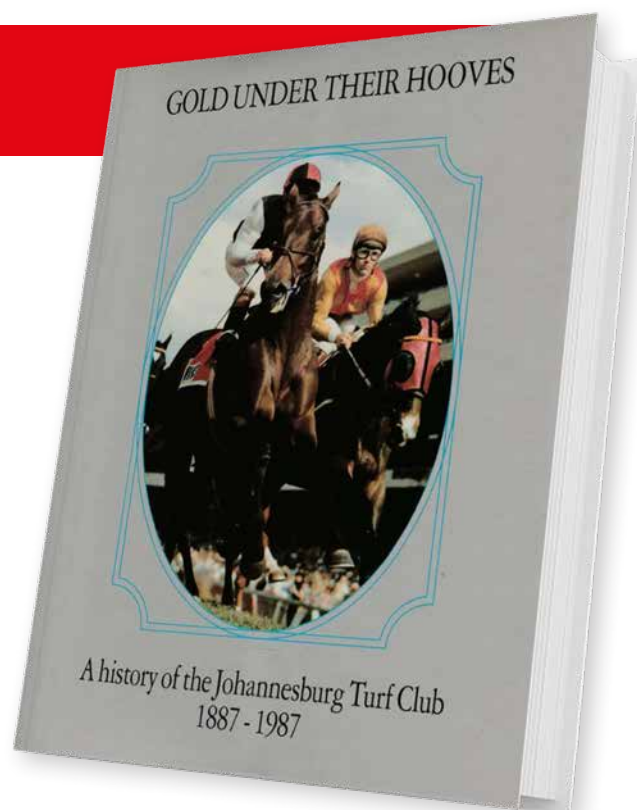

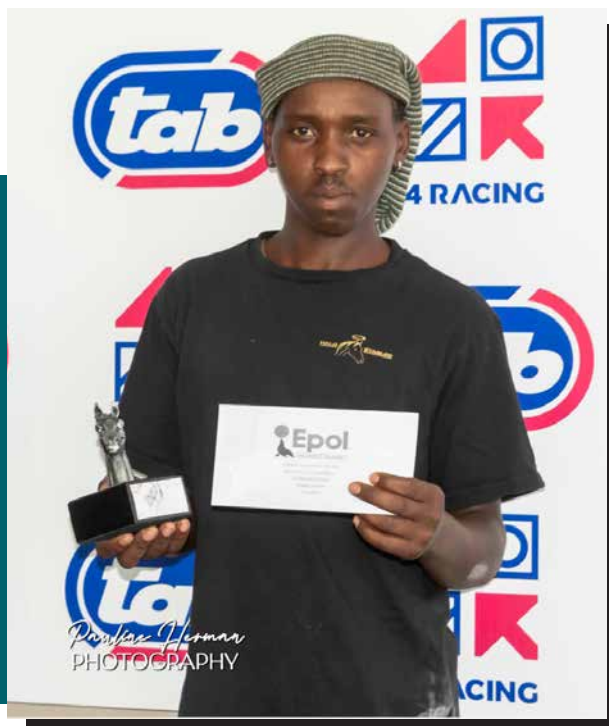
