4Racing's Groom Accommodation Renovation Update

As part of 4Racing's ongoing Transformation Initiative, the first phase of renovations of the Grooms' accommodation at Turffontein Racecourse is now 50% complete.

The renovation of Grooms' living quarters is one of the key aspects of the 4Racing Transformation initiative, as the previous accommodation on course was deemed unsuitable and unhealthy for grooms and in need of immediate upgrades.

4Racing has also partnered with the Racehorse Owners Association (ROA) on a range of Grooms benefits, for which 4Racing and the ROA have committed considerable funding for elements such as the provision of funeral cover and medical benefits to improve the working conditions and welfare of Grooms and Stable Hands.

The Grooms accommodation project has been divided into two phases, with phase one focusing on the renovation of the double-story accommodations, with 4Racing pleased to share significant progress having been made on this project.

"We have already witnessed remarkable improvements in this phase, marking a significant milestone in the project. The interior of half of the double-story accommodations has been completely revamped, including tiles, ceilings, painting of the walls and fixing of bathrooms," said Lunde Bleni, 4Racing's Executive for Stakeholder Labour Relations and Transformation.

During the renovation process, grooms have been temporarily located at alternative accommodation within the Turffontein Racecourse.

This temporary arrangement includes sleeping rooms, kitchens and bathrooms with hot water, ensuring their comfort and convenience during the renovation process.

The construction team is working diligently to ensure on-track completion of the Grooms' accommodation on schedule by the end of this year.

The grooms eagerly await the completion of their new accommodation and are incredibly excited about the upgrades that lie ahead.

The 4Racing Transformation Initiative is aimed at empowering historically disadvantaged shareholders, including the company's dedicated employees and hardworking grooms in the horseracing industry.

4Racing appreciates your continued support and is committed to fostering a more inclusive and empowering environment for all stakeholders. Together, we can achieve remarkable milestones and make a positive impact in the horseracing industry.

Hollywoodbets Durban July final field with draws

With five runners in the 18-horse field, Justin Snaith holds a strong hand in this year's R5 million Gr1 Hollywoodbets Durban July after the field was announced at a glittering function in Umhlanga Rocks on 20 June 2023. Africa's greatest horseracing event, featuring the pinnacle race in the South African calendar will be run at Hollywoodbets Greyville over 2200m on Saturday July 1 where a full house of 55 000 people are expected through the turn styles.

23 runners were left at final acceptances and the three not to make the cut were Aragosta, Union Square and Electric Gold with Nebraas and Jimmy Don the two reserve runners, should any one of the final 18 be withdrawn prior to Friday, June 30.

The race will have an international flavour with Mike de Kock engaging multiple French Champion Jockey, Christophe Soumillon, to ride Safe Passage. Soumillon arrives on the Friday before the race and jets out shortly after. Safe Passage was a close-up second to Puerto Manzano in the G1 Betway Summer Cup. Puerto Manzano was always an automatic entry after that win but gave notice of his well-being by recently winning the Gr3 WSB Jubilee Stakes for Johan Janse van Vuuren.

Top weight Trip of Fortune was supplemented into the race with his connections forking out R30 195 for the privilege of running in the race, despite being allotted top weight of 60kg and never having run further than 1600m. Aldo Domeyer will be aboard for Candice Bass-Robinson.

Bernard Fayde'Herbe, with a riding infraction hanging over his head in Mauritius, has been given the green light to partner Pomp And Power for Justin Snaith.

Snaith also saddles veteran and twice winner of the race, Do It Again who completed his preparation in the recent Gr1 Hollywoodbets Gold Challenge. This will be his record sixth run in the race and Gavin Lerena, successful on Kommetdieding in 2020, will be aboard.

Also in the Snaith armory is Without Question, beaten odds-on favourite in the Gr1 SplashOut Cape Derby, third in the Gr1 Daily News 2000 and winner of the Gr3 Variety Club Mile. First call stable rider, Richard Fourie, had the pick of the Snaith runners so his decision could be significant.

Michael Roberts, 11-time South African Champion Jockey and successful aboard

Super Quality in 1997, will be hoping to find the winner's enclosure as a trainer as he saddles ruling ante-post favourite See It Again with veteran rider Piere Strydom in the irons. See It Again was a winner of the Gr1 SplashOut Derby and more recently the Gr1 Daily News 2000. Strydom, a four-time winner of the race, will be looking to equal the five wins by Anton Marcus.

Weiho Marwing will be hoping to rub out the disappointment of having Wylie Hall relegated to second behind Legislate in 2014 as he sends out Gr1 WSB SA Derby winner Son Of Raj who has quickly risen through the ranks for owner Stephen Chetty.

There are four fillies in the race including recent Gr1 Woolavington 2000 winner Rain In Holland, runner-up Time Flies, Silver Darling, winner of last year's Woolavington and third this season in both the Gr 1 Cartier Paddock Stakes and the Woolavington and Gr1 Wilgerbosdrift SA Fillies Classic winner Bless My Stars from the Sean Tarry stable.

Kabelo Matsunyane will be aboard Brett Crawford's gelding Winchester Mansion, second to Pacaya in the Gr2 WSB 1900 but booking his place with an impressive performance in the Gr3 Hollywoodbets Dolphins Cup Trial.

In the world of horse racing, where passion meets opportunity, there are individuals who break through barriers and leave their mark. The 21 year old Ewan Garratt, a promising young racehorse owner, is one such individual. Currently pursuing a Bachelor of Commerce degree in accounting, Ewan's love for horses and this sport runs deep. His mom, trainer Tara Laing who had her 500th winner just last month, and stepfather Gavin Venter who is a 16 time PE Champion jockey, are very supportive and quite the inspiration.

Outside of racing, Ewan enjoys cricket and is a huge rugby fan. He planned to pursue his dream by attending the Sharks Rugby Academy in 2021 but that did not go to plan due to a knee injury. This has then led him to focus more on his passion for racing. He decided to attend a BSA sale one year and looked through the catalogue about 15 times before finally finding his first horse.

A special moment for Ewan was when the first horse that raced in his silks, Chronicalsofnania, trained by mom Tara Laing, was a

winner. Unfortunately he was not on course however, explains that his university lecturer and fellow students will never forget Ewan shouting at his phone calling this horse home the last 400m of the race.

Ewan currently owns 7 horses and they are stabled at the Laing yard in the Eastern Cape. He dreams of achieving more in racing, winning feature races and perhaps having a runner in the Durban July.

He commends 4Racing for encouraging the younger generation to be part of the industry by giving them opportunities to race call. They have recently given the 19 year old Naqeeb Munshi the opportunity to commentate in Johannesburg and Ewan personally thinks that Naqeeb has talent and has a bright future ahead of him.
