Muzi Yeni wins his first ever Betway Summer Cup with Royal Victory, as the 'people's race' lives up to the hype

Big race rider Muzi Yeni and Royal Victory stormed home to win the R5 million 2023 Betway Summer Cup, which lived up to its billing as one of South Africa's biggest and best race days at a packed Turffontein Racecourse on Saturday, 25 November 2023.

The Highveld's richest horse racing event, the Betway Summer Cup, witnessed a heart-pounding showdown in a thrilling Gr1 main race that had the crowd at the Big T on their feet! It was an imperious 2.25 length victory for trainer Nathan Kotzen and owners Brandon Wiese, Natasha

Sturdy and Peter Victor, with the first KZN-based runner this century to win the Betway Summer Cup, as Royal Victory embraced the 'Summer Reign' theme of the People's Race to emerge as Turffontein racing royalty.

The Gr2 Jonsson Workwear Dingaans was another cracker of a race and won in brilliant fashion by Purple Pitcher with jockey Kabelo Matsunyane thundering home to nab Gimmeanotherchance on the line for a famous win in the final stride for owner Stinkie Pooe and trainer Robyn Klaasen.

A huge crowd was in attendance at the home of South African horseracing, as 4Racing and Betway staged an unforgettable day of thrilling thoroughbred racing, with the backdrop of breath-taking Joburg views and thumping entertainment headlined by a fantastic Half Time Show featuring DJ Zihle and Lady Du.

The race day was pure excitement from start to finish, but it wasn't just the incredible racing that stole the show on a family fun Jozi day, in which the event's theme of 'Summer Reign' burst into vibrant life on a sweltering day on the Highveld.

The glitzy Red Carpet dazzled with Johannesburg's finest socialites and the who's who of the horseracing and sporting industries.



The likes of former national cricket captain Graeme Smith, Kaizer Chiefs Marketing and Commercial Director Jessica Motaung, former Bafana Bafana internationals Sphiwe Tshabalala, Lucky Legwathi and Hlompho Kekana, as well as sports broadcaster Motshidisi Mohono, were among those who brought glitz and glam to the Red Carpet, along with 4Racing CEO Fundi Sithebe, Purple Group CEO and 4Racing Board Chairperson, Charles Savage, and glamorous Gauteng MEC for Economic Development, Tasneem Motara.



In keeping with the theme of the Betway Summer Cup being the 'People's Race' all the hard-working Grooms who lovingly nurtured the horses in the final field of the Betway Summer Cup were awarded an amazing R20 000 each by Betway, and they all left the course as winners, regardless of where their charges finished.

The renowned DJ Zinhle had everyone dancing with her beats, making the whole racecourse pulsate with energy and when Lady Du hit the stage, the crowd went wild!

The fashion on the day was absolutely incredible, with everyone interpreting the 'Summer Reign' theme in various ways. African Luxury Design House and partner-Excelsior Lusso showed off their amazing new collection - Lekgawa la di Kgosigadi on models strutting down the red carpet, turning heads and making jaws drop.

The Betway Summer Cup's destination partner, Joburg Tourism Company, added to the People's Race theme with a fantastic on-course Joburg Summer Fashion Market, showcasing 20 local SMME's who displayed their wares to the crowds at Turffontein.

Lindsay Saker Alberton, the motor partner for the 2023 Betway Summer Cup.

Tony Moodley's passion for the sport started at a very young age. He grew up in a little town called Shakaskraal and years after moving up to Johannesburg, he attended a speakeasy in Alberton where many trainers and jockeys would socialize. It was at this event that Tony was introduced to Scott Kenny. A few months later he purchased his first horse named SEE A PENNY. Described as a big, chestnut Summerhill Stud bred colt sired by ONLY A POUND, who went on to win quite a few races for Tony.

In his 31 years of owning racehorses, Tony's standout memory is lifting the Gr1 Summer Cup trophy on 29 November 2008, when the Mike de Kock-trained "RUDRA", won the prestigious race for the partnership. IRRIDESCENCE has also earned Tony and his partners the Gr1 SA Fillies Classic in 2005, and two 3rd place runs in the Durban July respectively with EQUAL IMAGE in 2006 and BOUND BY HONOUR in 2008.

Among the equine athletes who have produced great results for Tony, he also owned horses named HAVASHA, KISS FOR KATE, CHECCETTI and LOCO POR GANAR. His past trainers include Scott Kenny, the Late Danie Burger Jnr, Patrick Shaw, Geoff Woodruff, Mike de Kock, Sean Tarry and his current trainer is Lucky Houdalakis who conditions WAR QUEEN and PEAK PREDATOR.

Tony is the proud owner of TM Stainless Steel (Pty) Ltd, a family owned and operated company that started in 1990. The establishment designs and manufactures a variety of food and beverage processing plants, from dairies to breweries as well as pharmaceutical companies. One of the most compelling aspects of Tony Moodley's story is the integration of family into both his business and racing endeavors. His wife Pat plays a pivotal role, managing the financial aspects of his racing ventures, ensuring that there are never any accounts that are paid late. Tony's son Nishen (who also works in the family business) serves as the racing manager, ensuring that all horses are well and provides feedback on every detail. His daughter Dr Arshnee Moodley, lives in Denmark and is an Associate Professor at Copenhagen University. Tony also treasures his role as a grandfather. He has four grandchildren who are his greatest blessings. In addition to his passion for racing, Tony is an avid supporter of soccer and Formula 1.

ROYAL VICTORY was victorious on the 25th of November, being the first KwaZulu-Natal based runner this century to win the Grade 1 Betway Summer Cup, as he ran a brilliant 2000m race at the Big T. It was only fitting that we caught up with the elated Peter Victor who part-owns this 4-year-old gelding, as we proudly announce him our Owner of the month after a thrilling Summer Cup event.

Peter grew up in Dinwiddie, Germiston, and was an avid racing enthusiast from his younger years. He then started owning horses in 2015. His horses were trained by Erico Verdonese who also produced Peter's first win in May 2016 with a horse named SHE'S A FLIRT. Juan Nel is one of Peter's current trainers in the Eastern Cape and he has horses conditioned by Corrie Lensley and Lucky Houdalakis on the Highveld, and with Nathan Kotzen in KwaZulu-Natal, who earned Peter his first Gr1 winner with ROAYL VICTORY. This gelding is also part owned by Brandon Wiese and Natasha Sturdy.

Peter continued his winning streak by leading in another winner with his other partners just three days after this magnificent win, as TERRA TIME (trained by Lucky Houdalakis) won Race 3 at the Vaal on 28 November 2023.

Peter successfully established and runs his own company called Black Crescent (Pty) Ltd. His wife Belinda and their son Michael are both passionate about racing too. Belinda has recently acquired her

own colours, starting her wonderful ownership journey and has joined the Racehorse Owners Association. All winners give Peter joy but winning the Summer Cup will remain etched in his memory as the pinnacle of his racing experience—a moment where elation and accomplishment combined created the best feeling in his journey as an owner.
