From the desk of the CEO

Dear Members

Welcome to the December edition of ROA Today.

This being the final edition of our monthly newsletter for 2023, I have paused to reflect on events that have taken place in the industry in recent weeks. The events from Summer Cup Day as well as the resultant outcomes have been extremely disappointing, particularly for owners. Racehorse owners play a pivotal role in the horseracing industry, serving as vital contributors to the sport's success and sustainability. I personally engaged with owners who were affected on the day and their distress and confusion was palpable. Mostly, this stemmed from the lack of information, and explanation given, particularly on such a high-profile day, where sadly, gossip and misinformation were then able to be spread unabated.

I am concerned with the treatment of owners; as an owner myself, I know that my interest always lies with the care and welfare of my horses, and I do believe other owners feel the same way. I am concerned about the lack of clarity and communication regarding key aspects of ownership, as transparency is essential for establishing trust and confidence within the racehorse ownership community. The ROA have begun taking the necessary steps to advocate for greater transparency and information provision to protect the interests of owners. We will be engaging owners and members directly with our Board proposals, including formal petitions to mobilise support for change. I believe these measures will not only protect the interests of owners but also contribute to the overall integrity and welfare of the racing industry. Transparent and well-informed owners are

more likely to make responsible decisions that prioritize the health and performance of their horses.

As owners are one of the most important stakeholders in horseracing, their involvement should be valued and supported through transparent communication, fair treatment, and opportunities for meaningful engagement in matters that affect their interests. I therefore encourage you to communicate with me directly on these issues as we work collectively to address these matters with the relevant bodies in racing, that way, there is a greater likelihood of effecting positive change within the industry.

I am delighted to announce the continuation of ROA Bonus Races for Maiden Plates run in 4Racing jurisdictions from January 2024. This equates to a contribution of R2.5 million over the next 5 months. This exclusive Bonus Stake incentive is an exciting opportunity to supercharge the thrill of raceday and reward ROA members for their loval support. Stakes maximisation remains one of the ROA's main strategic pillars, and where possible, one of the ways we strive to realise this objective, is with the supplementation of Stakes for our members through this bonus programme. Turn to page 2 for more detailed information on this popular initiative and I encourage all members who race in partnerships, to ensure their fellow patrons are up to date with their memberships in order to qualify for their full bonus. Let's raise the stakes, celebrate excellence, and drive the future of racing together!



THE RACEHORSE OWNERS ASSOCIATION R2,5 MILLON IN ADDED STAKES BONUS RACES

Saddle up for success and join the ROA in this opportunity to race for greater rewards!

We are pleased to announce the continuation of added Stakes Bonus races into the new year for ROA members in good standing. The Bonus Stakes will be made available for Open Maiden Plates (excluding A Division and Juvenile Maiden Plates) run in 4Racing jurisdictions from January to May 2024. This incentive has a total value of R2,5 Million and the ROA is extremely proud to be able to continue rewarding our loyal members with this added benefit.

The racing programme has been finalised until May 2024 and there are approximately 160 eligible races with R15 000 each in Added Stakes Bonuses to be claimed by ROA Members. This period includes the Summer/Autumn Highveld Feature Season as well as the prestigious East Cape Derby to be run at Fairview in May 2024. Furthermore, on selected feature days in the coming months and in order to add an extra layer of excitement, we will continue with our "**Super Bonus Races**" where bonus amounts of up to R40 000 can be won. These will be allocated to Maiden Plates run on specific premier feature race days, namely;



The bonuses will be paid together with the winning stakes to ROA Members in good standing. Should the winner be owned in partnership, both or all parties will have to be ROA Members in good standing to qualify for the full bonus. Failing this, the bonus will be halved. In the case of syndicates or companies, only the nominees of such entities need to be ROA Members to receive the full bonus. One would need to be a member of the Racehorse Owners Association for a period of at least 7 working days to qualify for a bonus cheque. Applications may take up to 7 working days to process.


South African Sport Industry Mourns the Loss of Jermaine Craig (1974 – 2023)

4Racing is deeply saddened by the passing of renowned South African luminary, communication entrepreneur and former journalist Jermaine Craig, who passed away on 4 December 2023, aged 49. Born in Cape Town, Jermaine's life journey was one characterised by dedication, passion, and a profound commitment to his family, and the fields he loved: media and communication.

With over 20 years' experience in media, Jermaine's professional journey included editorial leadership at The Cape Argus and The Star newspapers. He had significant achievements in sports journalism and was awarded the prestigious 1999/2000 Castle Premiership Football Writer of the Year. His reporting prowess extended to international events, where he covered the 2000 Sydney Olympics, the 2004 Athens Olympics, and the 2006 FIFA World Cup in Germany, and served as Media Relations Manager for the 2010 FIFA World Cup Organizing Committee in South Africa.

An entrepreneur at heart, Jermaine founded Craig Communications in 2018. As Managing Director, his commitment to excellence, creativity, and storytelling defined the ethos not only of the company, but extended to his clients including Kaizer Chiefs Football Club and horseracing operator, 4Racing.

Jermaine was gentle, generous, warm, and welcoming. His untimely departure leaves a void in the sport industry, and his professionalism, and innovative spirit will be remembered by colleagues, friends, and the many lives he touched throughout his illustrious career.



Our thoughts and condolences go out to his wife Michelle, and their two children, friends, and all who had the privilege of knowing and working with Jermaine.

"In the realm of communication and beyond, Jermaine Craig was a true maestro. His impact on 4Racing went beyond the professional; it was deeply personal. His dedication, creativity, and unwavering commitment to our vision made him an invaluable part of our journey. In his memory, we carry the echoes of his wisdom and the resonance of his spirit, forever grateful for the indelible mark he left on our hearts." said Fundi Sithebe, 4Racing CEO.

In his early years of horse ownership, Jock's wife was actively involved in his racing pursuits. Today, his son-in-law Phillip de Lange is a partner in the ownership of ROSEY LEMON. Moreover, with a keen grandson now showing interest, racing is a passion passed down through generations. Once an avid golfer and soccer player in his youth, he now finds joy in watching sports like cricket and rugby. An occasional poker game adds a touch of excitement to his retired life, free from the demands of the motor trade and property development. Now in the golden years of retirement, Jock relishes his roles as a father, grandfather, and great-grandfather. Despite stepping back from the business world, his love for racing persists, and he harbors hopes for more winning moments as an Owner. JJ has been in the racing industry for 30 years providing vast experience from all over the world. He worked for bookmakers on course in his younger days and then went on to work as a bookie with his father in Johannesburg. He now owns an international logistics company called Global Bloodstock Logistics.

ARAGOSTA kicked off JJ's December celebrations by winning the Cape Summer Stayers Handicap (L) on 2 December at Kenilworth Racecourse which was the start of the Cape Summer Season of Champions, and more recently, UNZEN (also bred by JJ) who was victorious in a 22-horse field claiming the World Sports Betting Grand Heritage title at the Vaal Racecourse on 9 December.

JJ has many memorable victories throughout his decades of experience in the sport, but his standout memory is the fantastic racing career that VICTORY MOON had for the Mad Syndicate in Dubai. VICTORY MOON (SAF), the bay son of AL MUFTI (USA) x DANCING FLOWER (SAF) had 8 runs, won 6 and placed twice. He was bred by Litchfield Stud and placed them on the international stage by winning the Gr2 UAE Derby, Gr2 Maktoum Challenge (Round 3), Gr3 Maktoum Challenge (Round 2) and Gr3 UAE 2000 Guineas in Dubai. He also ran third in the Gr1 Dubai World Cup in 2004. He then went on to Maine Chance Farms for stud duties.

JJ currently owns 4 horses in partnerships and his trainers are Mike de Kock who is a very good friend of his, and Robbie Sage who JJ has known for a very long time and is his good friend as well.

Family is very important to JJ, and his three grandchildren keep him quite busy.

We wish JJ and his partners a wonderful continuation of success throughout the season and best wishes for the new year.
