Welcome to the February edition of ROA Today!

The Racing Renaissance, Cape Summer Season of Champions culminated with the running of the Grade 1 SplashOut Cape Derby on Saturday 24th February. The day was well attended with Hollywoodbets Kenilworth Racecourse playing host to a Seafood and Jazz Racing Festival. Congratulations to all of the connections of the winner, Green With Envy, who clearly enjoyed the 2000m trip.

Feature racing returns to the Highveld this coming Saturday with the running of the TAB SA Classic (G1) and the Wilgerbosdrift SA Fillies Classic (G1). The Wilgerbosdrift HF Oppenheimer Horse Chestnut Stakes (G1), the TAB JJ The Jet Plane Stakes (G3), the Storm Bird Stakes (L), the Ruffian Stakes (L) and the Acacia Stakes (L) will also be run on the same day. As Classic Day is a premier feature day on the Highveld, the ROA is pleased to announce that we will once again be awarding a "Super Bonus" cheque to the winner of the Jermaine Craig Memorial Maiden Plate being run on the day.

To date, we are proud to announce that we have paid out more than R 717 000 in bonuses since the start of 2024. We look forward to rewarding many more of our loyal members in the months to come.

Jackie Sparke is a qualified Chartered Accountant (SA) and boasts over 33 years of experience in finance and tax. Most recently, she was the Finance Director for Mary Oppenheimer Daughters until December 2021 and retired in June 2023. Jackie served as a director of numerous family companies and had been with E Oppenheimer & Son (Pty) Ltd from September 2003 until 30 June 2018, when her employment contract was transferred to Mary Oppenheimer Daughters (Pty) Ltd. One could say the rest is history as Mrs Geriatrix went on to win Champion Two-Year-Old Filly at the Highveld Feature Season Awards and the Equus Awards for the 2022/2023 season.

Being part of the syndicate has been an incredibly exciting and rewarding experience for Jackie, she says "Despite being associated with stud and racing activities for many years I never dreamed that I would ever own a racehorse but the syndicate made a dream come true. I am proud to be involved with such a dynamic group of ladies and have shared many special and exciting moments and memories over the last couple of years. We were all super gifted when Sean Tarry, our phenomenal trainer, found our fairy tale filly Mrs Geriatrix who has real class and above all the biggest heart. It has been the most amazing journey for me and often have to pinch myself that it is for real"

Jackie has since retired from day-to-day corporate activities and now provides financial and tax consulting services. She brings extensive corporate experience, financial and tax acumen and by being an owner in a modern South African racing context, she offers substantial insight into the racing experience for current and potential owners. Especially from a syndication or fractional owner point of view, areas which are key to the future sustainability of the sport.

4Racing's 'The Championships Season' Continues with Classic Day at Turffontein Racecourse



After a great start to 'The Championships Season', racing fans are eagerly anticipating the second leg of the season, Classic Day, taking place on Saturday 2 March, at Turffontein Racecourse. Classic Day will feature three Grade 1 races, namely the R1.5 million TAB Gauteng Classic, the R1.25 million Wilgerbosdrift SA Fillies Classic, and lastly the R1.5 million H F Oppenheimer Horse Chestnut Stakes, named in honour of the legendary Horse Chestnut, South Africa's Triple Crown winner in 1999 and his part owner and breeder, Mr. H F Oppenheimer.

The season began with Guineas Day on 3 February and saw Sandringham Summit – a 3-year-old colt by Gimmethegreenlight, bred by Varsfontein Stud and trained by the Turffontein-based trainer David Nieuwenhuizen, clinch the win in the 1st leg of the SA Triple Crown, the Grade 2 TAB Guineas. Gimme A Nother – a 3-year-old filly from the Mike de Kock yard, bred by Wilgerbosdrift and Mauritzfontein also emerged victorious in the 1st leg of the SA Triple Tiara, the Grade 2 Wilgerbosdrift Gauteng Fillies Guineas.

"The season kicked off with notable performances all round, one such was the Fabian Habib-trained Zeus scoring his 10th career victory with all 10 wins achieved with Gavin Lerena in the saddle, which was also a personal record for the jockey. After this record, we saw Lerena riding Sandringham Summit, a horse that has had 8 career starts to date, including winning the Grade 1 Premiers Champion Stakes, the Grade 2 Durban Golden Horseshoe and becoming Equus Champion two-year-old colt. With TAB set to once again return as the sponsors for the second leg of the SA

Triple Crown, Classic Day can only level-up from the incredible kick-off, and we look forward to seeing the next chapter unfold in the SA Triple Crown and SA Triple Tiara series where we will hopefully witness the emergence of new champions," said Fundi Sithebe, 4Racing CEO.

In keeping with the big purses on the day, TAB4Racing's 'Champions of The Championships' competition continues, with one punter currently topping the leader board and, in the running, to secure the R100 000 cash prize if they maintain their lead after Classic Day.

Should the current log leader lose their top spot-on Classic Day, the R100,000 grand prize falls away, however that will create an opportunity for two other lucky punters to win a share of the impressive cash prizes. The first-place winner with the highest competition balance at the end of the season will walk away with a R10 000 cash prize, while second place walks away with R5 000, and third place with R2 500. The upcoming Classic Day will also welcome the first ever "Parade Ring Party" at Turffontein racecourse. verbally abusive to Security & Racing Operation staff. These staff are on-site for the sake of all Turffontein patrons who deserve a world-class race day experience.

With two of our biggest events coming up, Classic Day (2 March) and Champions Day (6 April), 4 Racing would like to remind everyone of the Parade Ring Dress Code:

Parade Ring Dress Code (Men):

- Top:** Collared Shirt or Golf Shirt (No Jacket Required)
T-shirt (Jacket Required)
- Bottom:** Long pants
- Shoes:** Closed shoes or smart sneakers
- NOT ALLOWED:** Shorts, sandals, flip flops or boardshorts

Parade Ring Dress Code (Women):

- Recommended:** Dresses or ensembles (top & skirt) are recommended
- Bottoms:** Trousers, smart jeans & shorts
- Shoes:** Heels, Wedges, Smart Sandals & Smart Sneakers
- NOT ALLOWED:** Boardshorts, flip flops

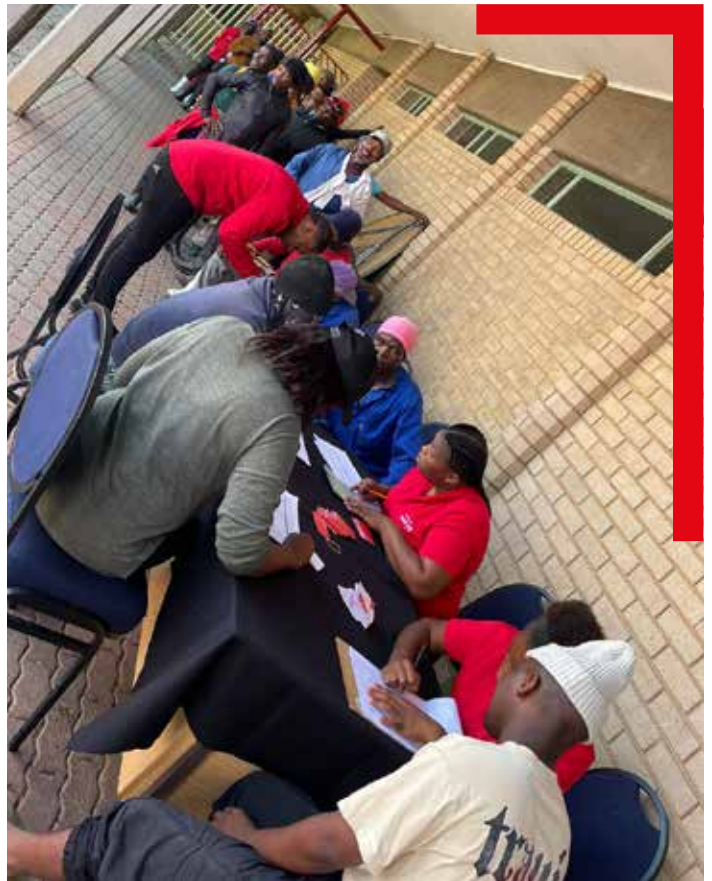
Grooms Wellness Days

John had a lovely start to the Gauteng Guineas Day when a 3-year-old filly he part owns named BLUP BLUP, won the first of our SUPER BONUSSES for the year earlier this month.

John is no stranger to the racing industry as his involvement began at the age of 16, when he acted as his father's runner between bookmakers on raceday to ensure that the best odds were secured. Later, when John served in the military, he often spent weekends at Mauritzfontein Stud, as a family member, Eric Young was employed there and this sparked his fascination and passion for horses. It wasn't until 1996 that John took the leap into ownership, propelled by the encouragement of his cousin, Len De Lange and since then, there has been no turning back for John, as his love for horses has only intensified with time.

John is currently involved with 10 horses in training, all within partnerships and him being the majority shareholder in two horses stabled at the David Nieuwenhuizen yard. Many good relationships with trainers have been created over the years, which has given John great results throughout his journey as an owner. Gavin Smith has been John's first and longest standing trainer and secured 31 victories for him. David Nieuwenhuizen is John's newest and current trainer, whom John describes as arguably one of the most underrated trainers in the country and whom he wishes was provided with more opportunities from owners. David has delivered six winners from four runners in the last two years for John. Throughout his racing journey, John has also had the pleasure of working with trainers including David Rahilly, Craig Mayhew, Mike McLachlan, Stephanie Miller, Paul Peter, Duncan Howells, Jacques Strydom and Gary Alexander. He has been fortunate to have celebrated a total of 45 winners under the guidance of these trainers.

John's fervent passion for advertising and creativity knows no bounds. Anything related to marketing or innovation captures his attention and enthusiasm. He is one of the founding members and the Managing Director of GO Advertising, an advertising agency which is a retail arm and a subsidiary of the Ogilvy South Africa Group.

Away from the hustle and bustle of his professional life, John finds solace in his travels with his wife Delia. While John's heart finds its home in the bush, Deila's soul is soothed by the tranquil embrace of the sea. Despite their differing preferences, the couple's shared love for exploration often leads them to Phuket, Thailand, a destination that they both love. Their children live abroad so they enjoy watching their horses run and spending time with their beloved dogs.

While John has experienced numerous memorable victories, three have truly stood out for him. One being his first ever winner on the 6th March 1998, with ROYAL CHAMBER, another is that of EXCLUDED, a bay gelding who won in John's racing silks for the first time at Fairview Racecourse on 1st May 2015. Lastly, he recalls CELTIC RUSH, the 4-year-old gelding who holds a special place in John's heart as his first winner on the Highveld in his own silks on Sunday the 11th of June 2023.

John has been a member of the ROA for a decade this year and believes that the ROA contributes significantly to the racing industry. He is of the opinion that the annual fees are a small price to pay for the ROA bonuses. He recognizes the value these bonuses bring and appreciates the attention to detail we provide from a hospitality perspective.
